

MVA awarded contract for Consultancy Services for Lyric Theatre and Hotel, Office & Residential Enabling Study of the West Kowloon Cultural District



November 11, 2014 – The West Kowloon Cultural District (WKCD) is a strategic investment by the Government of Hong Kong Special Administrative region to meet the growing demand in arts and culture infrastructure. MVA is involved as lead transport consultant on many areas of the development.

The 1,200-seat Lyric Theatre will be Hong Kong's first world-class facility for dance performances, including ballet, contemporary and Chinese dance forms. It will sit alongside M+ at the western end of the WKCD, and be accessible via Artist Square and the waterfront promenade. To create vibrancy for the WKCD, retail, dining and entertainment facilities as well as hotel, office and residential developments will be suitably integrated with the arts and cultural facilities and other developments within the WKCD.

MVA scope of works included detailed design of car parking and transport servicing layout, internal road and prepare necessary traffic and transport related government submission.
